Vidal Blanc: The aroma of a spring time garden, a subtle bouquet of pear with citrus fruit characteristics comes alive with baked chicken, roasted duck and smoked foods. Superb with shrimp, lobster, or scallops. Fresh basil and garlic are two spices that compliment this fine dry white. Serve chilled.

Norton Vintner's Reserve: A distinctively complex dry red with characteristic of the wines made famous by Adam Puchta in the 1800's. French and American oak aging intensifies the richness. The bouquet exhibits rich cherry, red raspberry and vanilla qualities with subtle hints of spice, tea, and licorice in the background. Wonderful with dark chocolate.

Hunters Red: A velvety semi-dry red, medium bodied and non-oaked with a mild floral nose. A fun wine to pair with many Italian foods, peppery/spicy BBQ, hearty stews, venison and summer sausage. A choice red wine to cook with. Best served at room temperature.

Vignoles: A luscious semi-sweet white wine bursting with the essence of peach, strawberry and kiwi fruit, finishing with a sweet crisp citrus taste. This versatile wine may be paired with spicy Mexican, and Cajun food. Very tasty with lemon chicken or lime shrimp.

Jazz Berry: If you are a chocoholic you are sure to love Jazz Berry! A fruity sweet wine with intense bouquet and taste of fresh raspberries. Served chilled with desserts made with dark chocolate, crème brulee, custards and even over ice cream.

Half Court Light: Reminiscent of a fine Chardonnay, the aroma of Half-Court Light then moves on to white pepper and pine from the Tettnang hops, and freshly-baked bread from the malted white wheat. The subtle hopping gives way to a soft mouthfeel with a crisp, slightly tart lime finish.

Knock-Out Blond opens with a fresh wildflower honey and lemongrass nose accompanied by green apple and sweet basil. The faintly floral aroma melds into a rich, full palate with a clean pilsner malt character. The slight sweetness and balanced classic hops come to a neat finish.

Face-Off Pale Ale opens with a medley of grapefruit, apricot, cherry and ripe bananas. The copper colored brew then moves on to an herbal hop nose of rosemary, basil and fennel. Supported by a clean tea-biscuit malt palate the brew melts into a fruity hop finish. While rich and complex, this Pale Ale finishes cleanly.

Red Zone Lager: Gingerbread, nutmeg and anise aromas enliven this full-bodied amber lager. Red Zone balances rich malts with a clean hop presence, accentuated by dry-hopping with German Hallertauer hops. The smooth caramel character underscoring the brew finishes with a hint of toffee without being cloying.

Hard Ball Dark courts the senses with aromas of molasses, bourbon and French roast coffee beans. A rich chocolate mocha palate with a hint of licorice is enriched with a big round mouthfeel. The dark malt character is punctuated with a subtle herbal hop presence, and closes with a welcome hint of amaretto.

Marquee Classic Riesling – 2007 (87 PTS Wine Enthusiast): The 2007 season was fairly warm across Western Australia, a fact showcased in this wine's pungent nose with hints of green grass. Off-dry in style with a luscious mouth feel and zippy acidity this wine offers the three main aspects of great Riesling...ripe fruit, acidity, and minerality. A wonderful wine that showcases a long citrus finish with fresh lime and a hint of sweetness.

Marquee Classic Chardonnay – 2006 (89 PTS Wine Spectator): Source from the Murray Darling, the 2006 vintage was picked early to ensure great structure thereby lowering the sugar levels. The harvested grapes were separated into five batches that each underwent differing treatments (malolactic fermentation, extended yeast lees time, etc.) to ensure the complex and smooth final blend. Fruit forward in style, refreshing pineapple, honeydew and light citrus styling are at play in this tropical Chardonnay.

Marquee Classic GSM – Grenache/Shiraz/Mourvedre – 2007 (92 PTS Beverage Testing Institute): GSM – is the acronym used in Australia to stand for the three grape types in this classic "Rhône Style" red blend. Grenache & Mourvedre sourced from the famous Claire Valley in South Australia were artfully blended with Shiraz from Swan Hill, Victoria for richness and spice. Matured in French oak, additional Grenache was used to keep the style light and lithe, yet complex and the flavors of raspberry, cherry with hints of darker fruit showcase the bright, fruit-forward style of winemaking from Australia.

Marquee Classic Shiraz – 2007 (89 PTS Wine Spectator): Produced in an easy drinking style this wine is entirely from estate grown fruit in Victoria. To add a level of complexity to the final blend, a portion of the wine was aged with premium French Oak. The lush mid-palate gives this wine a velvety structure with a bit of spice on the finish as well as a fruit forward with currants, plums, and a refined acidic profile.

Classy Sauvignon Blanc – 2006 (87 PTS Wine Enthusiast): An elegant Sauvignon Blanc produced and bottled with partner X Winery from Napa, California retains good acidity and tropical flavors similar to the bouquet. Luscious melon and mango remain on a clean, lingering finish. This Sauvignon Blanc is a blend of fruit from two vineyards (Syler & Shannon) in Lake County that are very close to Clear Lake, the largest "natural lake" in California. The proximity to the lake helps regulate the extreme temperatures of the region and are accentuated by the cool growing season of 2006.

Classy Zinfandel – 2006 (87 PTS Beverage Testing Institute): Blended from two estate vineyards, the two sites were chosen to match higher acid levels with long and smooth tannins which focuses on showcasing the "American Varietal" Zinfandel with a touch of American Oak and no malolactic fermentation. Raspberries, blackberry jam, and cinnamon give the Zin lover a smooth ride.
