## Fees Listed Under Each Department

### Arrival and Release of Breeding Cattle

An earliest arrival time will be stated for some departments. An earlier arrival may necessitate staying outside the buildings. The management determines arrival and release times in an effort to make the best use of available space and to provide the best possible show for all exhibitors, special groups in attendance and the general public. For cattle arriving the first week (Braunvieh, Gelbvieh, Lowline, Mini Herefords, and Salers) the American Royal barns will be available after 8:00 a.m. Wednesday, October 19. For cattle arriving the second week (Angus, AOB/Commercial, Charolais, Hereford, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Shorthorn, and Simmental) the American Royal barns will be available after 8:00 a.m. Wednesday, October 26. **Exhibitors are expected to keep their livestock on display until the designated time for release** unless the Livestock Manager grants permission for early release. Failure to comply with this rule can result in forfeiture of premiums. The stated release time should be considered when a decision to enter is made.

If necessary, to allow time for cleanup, exhibitors are expected to remove animals and tack from tie space promptly after release time if asked by the management to do so.

All animals, tack and equipment must be removed from the American Royal Barns by 11:59 p.m., Sunday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> for cattle showing the first week. All animals, tack and equipment must be removed from the American Royal Barns by 11:59 p.m. Sunday, October 30<sup>th</sup> for cattle showing the second week. No livestock or equipment may be left on the American Royal grounds after 6:00 p.m., Monday, October 31<sup>st</sup>.

### Grooming Chutes

Exhibitors may use grooming chutes or cattle safety devices. Space will not be guaranteed for grooming chutes. A grooming chute permit is available for \$35.00 per chute. Any exhibitor failing to have a

grooming chute permit clearly visible will be subject to having chute removed from grounds. Chutes must be kept with exhibitors' cattle and cannot be placed in aisles, cleanout alleys, or fire lanes. Any exhibitor that does not comply promptly if requested by the management to remove a chute is subject to disciplinary action including forfeiture of premiums.

### Tie and Tack Space

Superintendents will assign tie space and tack space as needed upon arrival. The per-head fee is an entry fee not space rental. Due to limited space, ties will be assigned for the actual number of cattle that arrive at the show.

### Tie-outs

Breeding cattle may not be tied-out until 5:30 p.m. Temporary tie-outs are available at no charge on a first-come basis. Because most cattle will be on the grounds at the same time, please be considerate of fellow exhibitors and only use the tie-out space needed. The American Royal does not guarantee tie-out space and is not liable for security, accidents or loss of animals or articles in tie-out area. Cattle tie-outs are temporary panels and, as such, may not be substantial enough for some animals. Exhibitors, who elect to tie-out at night, do so at their own risk and are responsible for the security of their own animals. No tents are allowed in the tie-outs. Tents must be set in area designated as "tents only" by the Cattle Superintendent.

### Bedding

All cattle ties in the barn and the tie-out area will be bedded with material provided by the American Royal. **No other bedding material may be used.** The charge for bedding is included in the entry fee for all cattle.

### Substitution Rule:

**Substitutions may only be made within the breed entered.** Substitutions can be made only in the name of the original exhibitor/recorded owner as listed on the entry form and must be the same sex – bulls for bulls and females for females. Substitutions must be made with the current American Royal substitution form and postmarked no later than October 1, 2016. Substitution forms can be found in the premium book section of the website under forms. No substitutions will be allowed after October 1, 2016.

Any substitutions made, or attempted to be made in any breeding or market class through deceit may result in disqualification of all animals and parties involved. Said parties may be subject to subsequent actions by the Executive Committee.

**Substitution Fee: Breeding Cattle: \$20 per head.**

### **Cattle Sales**

Breed sales are under the management of the respective Associations. Sale managers or breed associations are requested to furnish the Livestock Department with a summary of their sales including totals and averages.

All live animals entered in any sale at the American Royal must be properly entered in the respective American Royal show. Owners are responsible for submitting completed entry forms along with required fees. Sale management must send a complete list of owners/sale animals to the American Royal by September 20.

### **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

Health requirements are located in the General Information section.

All livestock entering this show will be subject to examination by a show or State Veterinarian upon arrival or during the show.

Animals with active lesions of ringworm with resulting loss of hair, or multiple warts visible will not be permitted to exhibit. If animals have had ringworm, lesions must be dried and healed with hair growing back in. Any animal, of any species, showing evidence of infectious, contagious, or communicable diseases will be immediately withdrawn from the show, removed from the grounds, or held in quarantine at owner's risk and expense. These animals must remain in the quarantine area while on the grounds. Failure to cooperate may result in disqualification. There will be no refund of entry or other fees on animals withdrawn.

### **Parking and Passes**

Entry gates will be supervised. All exhibitors are required to purchase a minimum of 1 exhibitor badge; if traveling with someone else, it is not necessary to purchase a parking pass. A parking fee of \$10 per vehicle per entry and an admissions fee of \$5 per person per entry will be charged at the entry gates if passes are not purchased. See General Information for details on vehicle passes and grounds passes.

**NURSE COWS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED**

The American Angus Association's portion of the premiums is paid to the American Royal to be included in their premium checks to the exhibitors.

## **ROLL OF VICTORY SUPER POINT SHOW PARTICIPATION STATEMENT**

The American Angus Association, 3201 Frederick Avenue, St. Joseph, Missouri, will participate in premiums offered for open class Angus breeding cattle classes according to the premium schedule based on the number of head shown. The premium assistance provided by the American Angus Association for participation in this show is in addition to the premiums offered by the show itself. The premium assistance should not be used to offset show expense and shall be included in the premium payments distributed by the show to the exhibitors.

A minimum of 50 head must be shown in the open class division to receive American Angus Association premium participation for the following year.

Premiums from the Association are paid only to registered Angus cattle and only if the registration

number is a part of the show report provided to the Association. Therefore, all cattle should be registered at the time of the entry to make certain they receive the Association's portion of premiums. The Association does not pay on championship or any group classes.

**Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate issued by the American Angus Association available for inspection at the show for each animal or another current proof of ownership issued by the American Angus Association pedigree look up.**

Any animal, upon check-in, which does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks or hot-branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on the registration certificate is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals cannot be re-identified (tattooed/branded) and rechecked at the show.

**Any female shown with a calf at side: the calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf, and the calf must be registered by show day and have proof of registration at check-in.**

**Only one person at a time shall lead an animal into the show ring.**

Exhibitors who participate in shows that accept premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association are subject to the Association Rules as found in the Breeders Reference Guide of the Association. These rules are found in Part 2; Association Rules. The rules relating directly with the exhibition of Angus cattle are Part 2: Association Rules; Rule 800 Series; including Rule 800-810. These rules can be found at [www.angus.org](http://www.angus.org).

Altering the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the use of chin straps, covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), with the exception of false tail switches. The use of graphite, powders, hemp or other similar substances used externally are also prohibited. Other prohibited products include those used internally such as steroids, illegal or unlicensed pharmaceuticals or artificial filling. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.

At any show for which the American Angus Association appropriates funds toward the payment of premiums, no exhibitors, individuals assisting exhibitors or member owners at such show shall be allowed to use any coloring agents, on any animal

exhibited. The Association may adopt and implement various tests designed to monitor this prohibition, including but not limited to a “white towel” or “white glove” test. No aerosol cans or other pressurized containers will be allowed in designated line up areas.

All animals exhibited are subject to DNA marker or blood type test to verify accuracy of parentage as covered under the Association Rules and for other testing as required by the individual show.

Authorized representatives of the Association have the authority to enforce the rules set forth herein as well as in the Association Rules, including the barring of a registered animal from a livestock show at which it is to be shown, if there are reasonable grounds to believe a violation has occurred.

### **AMERICAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION SHOW CLASSIFICATION**

Only registered Angus cattle that meet the age requirements listed within this classification are eligible to receive premium participation and be counted in the total number of head shown. Champion and Reserve Champion placings are not counted in the number of head shown.

### **PREMIUMS**

First place in each individual class will receive \$100 and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis among the other animals after the show has been completed. Premiums will not be paid in group classes.

**Show management reserves the right to split large classes if deemed necessary.**

### **FEMALES**

Any female that qualifies for female classes in the Association’s standard classifications are not eligible to show in the cow-calf classes. However, the calf at side of the female is eligible to show in its respective class providing individual entry has been made. Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Cow-Calf pairs do not show for Grand Champion Female and are ineligible to compete in the get-of-sire, junior get-of-sire and breeder’s six-head classes.

3. Purchased heifers in the AOB/Commercial division must have a bill of sale showing an ownership date on or before September 10, 2016.
4. Heifers that show in this division are not eligible for any other show.
5. All animals must have a permanent tattoo and ID must be listed on entry form.
6. Heifers will show by age in the classes listed below.
7. Commercial heifers entered with only a month listed for their birthday will automatically be entered as being born on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month.

8. This show is intended for the exhibitors of junior breeding heifers (not market animals) of All Other Breeds (including appendix and low percentage heifers that are not eligible to show in another breed show) and Commercial Heifers that do not have a separate breed show at the American Royal. Registered heifers that meet the qualifications for a junior breed show already held at the American Royal must show in that breed show.

## **BRAUNVIEH SHOW**

The Missouri Braunvieh Association's portion of the premiums is paid to the American Royal to be included in their premium checks to the exhibitors.

### **RULES**

1. American Royal entry forms, properly filled out and accompanied by the appropriate fees must be postmarked, or submitted online (online entries will only be available until September 16), by September 20, 2016.
2. The American Royal will keep \$75 of the per head entry fee and the balance will be remitted to the Association to be used for premiums.
3. Animals competing in the Braunvieh Show must be duly registered in the Braunvieh Association of America Herdbook. All animals exhibited must have a known Braunvieh dam or sire and are subject to being DNA verified to its Braunvieh parent(s).
4. Animals must be Fullblood or Purebred (7/8 Braunvieh blood for females; 15/16 Braunvieh blood for males) to qualify for the FB/PB Braunvieh Show. Animals with less than purebred Braunvieh blood, and 1/8 or greater Braunvieh blood will be shown in a separate Braunvieh Beef Builder show.
5. All entries must be halter broken to lead as they will show individually in Hale Arena.
6. Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of show entry deadline. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual classes.
7. All cattle must be properly tattooed, including herd prefix, and will be inspected at the show. Tattoo must be legible and must match registration papers.
8. All cattle must meet the health requirements set out by the show management. Any deviation will be just cause for immediate disqualification from the show.
9. All bulls born before January 1, 2015 must show with a noselead. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show officials.
10. All females born before August 31, 2014 must be shown with calf at side. All females born September 1, 2014 through April 30, 2015 must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of safe in calf will apply to: 1.) a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian or 2.) females shown with calf at side.
11. All females shown in Cow-Calf class with a calf over 150 days of age must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the safe in calf rule will apply to a donor female that has produced eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified by a written statement from a licensed veterinarian.
12. Cow-Calf classes – Calf must be cow's natural calf. Cows that are exhibited with calves at side must be lactating. Calves must not exceed 240 days of age on day of judging and must be nursing. Calf entries in the Cow-Calf class may be shown individually providing individual entry has been made. Cows may be evaluated and

screened out of the show on the basis of udder quality. The determination of the show committee will be final.

13. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation, or not abiding by the show rules, will be disqualified and denied the privilege of showing.
14. Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining thereto.

#### **PREMIUMS**

First place in each individual class will receive \$60. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place premiums may be paid based on the number of entries. The American Royal awards ribbons to the prize winners in class, rosettes to the division champions and banners to the grand champions.

**Show management reserves the right to split large classes if deemed necessary, in which case premium monies may be split.**

#### **BEEF BUILDER PERCENTAGE SHOW Bulls & Females**

(Less than 15/16 Braunvieh blood and greater than 1/8 Braunvieh blood)

The individual classes will be divided after the cattle are checked in. The Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions will be selected from the first and second prize winners. There will be no other division breaks.

The heifer classes will consist of females born on or after September 1, 2014. The cow/calf class will be for females born on or before August 31, 2014. There will be a maximum of 5 heifer and 1 cow/calf classes (Class #'s 23 – 28).

The bull classes will consist of bulls born on or after January 1, 2014. There will be a maximum of 5 bull classes (Class #'s 11 – 15).

## **AICA NATIONAL ROLL OF EXCELLENCE OPEN CHAROLAIS SHOW**

### **SPECIAL RULES**

All animals to be eligible for an Open Charolais Breeding Class must be purebred and registered with the AICA. Only bona fide (original) certificates of registration will be accepted as evidence of registration and ownership; NO PHOTOCOPIES.

An animal is eligible to enter or compete in an open Charolais breeding class if registered in country of origin outside the United States and is eligible for purebred registry in the AICA Herdbook.

Animals registered in the AICA Colored Division Registry (QF and QM initialed registration numbers) must meet the perimeters of the AICA Color Card.

All animals to be eligible may be approved by a sifting committee designated by the AICA. Stall space will not be provided for any Charolais cattle that have not been accepted by the sifting committee.

All animals are subject to a medical examination in order to determine age, and each animal will be present in the show ring in its natural conformation without alteration or modification. Use of artificial tailheads is not permitted.

Any animal not having a legible tattoo or firebrand number is ineligible and will be barred from showing.

Bulls from classes 28, 29, 30, 31 and 32 must have a valid, satisfactory semen test certificate in possession. This certificate is valid for the entire show season.

All animals shown in individual classes must be weaned, with the exception of the Cow-Calf class and calves at the side of females calved after September 1, 2014. Calves must be purebred and registered with the AICA. Females calved after September 1, 2014 must show in individual female class appropriate to age. Nurse cows are not permitted.

All females 20 months and older exhibited at AICA sanctioned shows must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy from a licensed veterinarian or have produced fertile eggs as certified in a written statement by a licensed veterinarian or embryologist or have a calf at side.

AICA requires that all animals be shown with a halter and suggests that all bulls be shown with a nose lead.

All exhibits of Charolais breeding cattle shall be governed by the AICA Rules and Regulations, Article XV, titled Exhibition of Animals. The inspection of exhibit cattle is specified in Article XV, paragraph C, of the Association Rules and Regulations and non-compliance of exhibit inspection is specified in paragraph D of the same Article XV.

Article XV, paragraph B, point 2: "Each animal will be presented in the show ring in its natural conformation and structure without alteration or modification. Alteration or modification shall be defined to include any surgical, chemical, electrical or other (including banding or circulatory constriction) appearance change for cosmetic purpose, save only branding, tattooing, foot trimming or dehorning. The act of artificially filling animals internally, which would include stomach pumping, drench tubes, or any other method per os (by esophagus) is prohibited. Silicone injection or other injection for cosmetic purpose shall be prohibited. Anabolic steroid use shall likewise be prohibited and any animal testing positive for anabolic steroid or diuretic use shall be presumed to be altered and modified."

The use of a coloring agent, flock and powder, is prohibited at any American-International Charolais Association (AICA) sanctioned show (including shows receiving AICA premium funding and/or qualifying as a Roll of Excellence Show). Use of these products will result in the immediate disqualification of a given animal at such show.

**If circumstances exist and/or allow, AICA reserves the right to split large individual classes after the check-in procedure is complete in which case premium monies may be split.**

## **GELBVIEWH & BALANCER RING OF GOLD POINT SHOW**

This will be a two division show: Gelbvieh and Balancer cattle. A Balancer is a specific hybrid registered by the AGA with the following breed composition and documentation requirements:

- A combination of  $\frac{1}{4}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$  Gelbvieh and  $\frac{1}{4}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$  Angus or Red Angus with a maximum of  $\frac{1}{8}$  unknown or other breed and
- The sire and dam must be recorded by an officially recognized organization (AGA, American Angus Association or Red Angus Association of America) and
- At least 75% of the pedigree must be known and documented by the AGA and/or another officially recognized registration association.

**NOTE: 75% females and bulls that qualify to be registered as Balancer or Gelbvieh can be entered and shown in only one division and may NOT be switched after entry deadline.**

## **RULES**

1. American Royal entry forms properly filled out and accompanied by the appropriate fees must be postmarked, or submitted online (online entries will only be available until September 16), by September 20, 2016.
2. The Royal will keep \$75.00 per head entry fee and the balance will be remitted to the Kansas Gelbvieh Association to be used for premiums.
3. All animals exhibited must be recorded in the name of the exhibitor by September 20, 2016. A copy of the registration paper or an affidavit of registration must accompany each animal to the show. It is not necessary to mail registration certificates with entries.
4. Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of the show entry deadline date. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual classes.
5. All animals must be properly tattooed, including herd prefix, and will be inspected at the show. Tattoos must be legible and must match registration papers.
6. All cattle must meet the health requirements set out by the show management. Any deviation from the health requirements will be just cause for immediate disqualification from show.
7. Show committee prohibits the use of powders of any color. False tailheads and glued-on hair or hair-like substances are prohibited. Any use of glue to alter the natural conformation of the animals will be an automatic disqualification.
8. Bulls exhibited at 14 months of age or older must have a positive semen test and a certificate to that effect must be available for inspection.
9. **ALL BULLS MUST SHOW WITH A NOSELEAD.** Entry into the show ring without one will be an automatic disqualification. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the Show Officials.
10. All females entered in junior yearling and senior yearling classes must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of "safe in calf" will apply to a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the current year, as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian.

11. All females shown in the cow-calf class with a calf over 150 days of age must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Age of calf must not exceed 240 days as of the date of the show.
12. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation or not abiding by the show rules will be disqualified and denied the privilege of showing.
13. All protests against exhibitors, dealing with age or genetic background of show cattle, must be in writing and signed by five active members of the AGA and accompanied by a deposit of \$500 cash or certified check which will be forfeited if protest is not sustained. Such protest must state plainly the cause of complaint or appeal and must be delivered to the office of the Livestock Manager within one hour after the occasion of such protest, or if age is brought into question, on the day prior to the one on which the animals are to be judged.

**EPDs will be available in the show program and given to the judge to use at his discretion.**

## **AMERICAN ROYAL NATIONAL HEREFORD SHOW RULES**

**1.** American Royal entry forms properly filled out and accompanied by appropriate fees must be postmarked, or submitted online (online entries will only be available until September 16), on or before September 20, 2016.

**2.** Cattle entered must be registered in the Herd Book of the American Hereford Association. Entries with registrations "pending" or illegible tattoos, or improper tattoos as shown on the registration certificate at check - in time are ineligible for competition. Exhibitors are subject to the American Hereford Association special rule on class qualification. Entries in these classes are accepted with the understanding that the exhibitor agrees to abide by the rule in all respects.

**3.** The exhibition of cattle displaying false hair will not be allowed.

**4.** Any product administered internally or used externally to alter the conformation of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the use of graphite, hemp or other similar substances externally and steroids or growth stimulants internally.

**5.** The act of artificially filling animals internally. Which includes stomach pumping, drench tubes or any other method by mouth or esophagus is prohibited.

**6.** All animals shown in group classes must have been shown in their respective single age class. No transfer from one (1) breed to another, after entry, will be permitted.

**7.** Expected Progeny Difference (EPD) values will be provided to the judge and audience for all animals shown. Animals without EPD data are eligible to show, but will have N/A (not available) in place of missing data

**8. It is recommended by the AHA Show Committee that classes with 10 or more head be considered to be split, depending on animals' birthdates in each particular class.**

**9.** Any animal without a legible tattoo will not be eligible to show.

**10.** All Hereford animals must be officially recorded (registered) thirty (30) days prior to show date to be eligible to show at a National Hereford Show.

11. An animal that is scurred (Scurs are small, rudimentary horns that are loosely attached to the head, which are considered to be expressed only in animals that are genetically heterozygous for the polled gene) will show in the polled division of Hereford shows. Once an animal is confirmed to be scurred by an AHA field representative, then this designation will be placed on the animal's registration papers. Once this determination has been made and reported to the AHA office, then the owner may remove the scurs. Animals with scurs removed will show in the polled division of Hereford shows. Once an animal is confirmed polled or scurred they will retain this designation forever.

## **AMERICAN ROYAL LEVEL I MEDAL OF EXCELLENCE SHOW**

### **RULES**

1. American Royal entry forms, properly filled out and accompanied by the appropriate fees, must be postmarked, or submitted online (online entries will only be available until September 16), on or before September 20, 2016. Include tattoo as well as registration number on entry form. Cattle must be entered in the same name that appears on the animal's registration certificate as the current owner.
2. The American Royal will keep a \$75.00 per head entry fee and the balance will be remitted to the North American Limousin Foundation to be used for premiums. The North American Limousin Foundation's portion of the premiums is paid to the American Royal to be included in their premium checks to exhibitors.
3. Animals must be registered with the North American Limousin Foundation.

4. All cattle shown must be:
  - a. 75% Limousin (NALF percentage, not actual) or greater as indicated on orange NALF registration certificates
  - Or
  - b. Purple-papered Lim-Flex cattle as indicated by NALF registration certificates.

Percentage, fullblood, purebred and Lim-Flex cattle shall compete in the same classes and championships.

5. If a show does not abide by the NALF MOE show rules exhibitors will not be awarded points for that show.
6. Animals must be properly tattooed and will be inspected at the show. Tattoos must be legible and match the registration certificates. If an animal's tattoo is not legible or cannot be read upon initial processing, it will be ineligible to show and not be allowed to return with a new or corrected tattoo.
7. To maintain a high degree of confidence in Limousin shows, NALF reserves the right to disqualify any animal that has been fitted in an unethical manner. Unethical fitting shall include the following:
  - a. Any use of paints, colored show foam, graphite, colored powders or any other substances; animals subject to white towel test.
  - b. The addition of any hair or hair like substances, including false tailheads and false polls (false tail switches are allowed.)
  - c. The cutting, tearing or gluing of the hide or underneath the hide or removal of tissue in an attempt to alter the shape of the animal or the injection of any gas, solid or liquid under the hide to alter the normal conformation.
  - d. Any products, solutions, liquids administered internally or externally to alter the conformation of the animal is prohibited. This includes the use of steroids, growth stimulants, and the act of artificially filling animals internally which would include stomach pumping, drench tubes or any other method.

**EXCEPTIONS:** In the case of severely sick or severely dehydrated animals, the exhibitor may have fluids or electrolytes administered by the licensed official show veterinarian with the approval of the show superintendent and/or NALF representative. This exception is not applicable on show day or weigh-in/check-in day.

8. Bulls older than one (1) year of age must show with a nose lead. The Limousin Show Superintendent and the show management reserve the right to disqualify animals deemed unmanageable.
9. Protests against exhibitors, individual animals or fitting violations must be submitted in writing, signed by five (5) active members of the NALF and presented to the show superintendent within 12 hours of the show's completion. See Protests in the Rules and Regulations.
10. NALF reserves the right to mouth animals for dental development.
11. NALF reserves the right to collect hair samples from any animal.
12. Classes and Championship breaks will be determined after all the cattle have been checked in. Class size shall be to the discretion of the show superintendent and may not contain more than 20 head. The given classes may be split or combined only within their given division.
13. Premiums will be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place in the individual classes will receive \$65. Any additional premiums may be pro-rated based on the total number of entries.
14. Calves exhibited alongside dams in the cow-calf division are eligible to show as individuals.
15. Animals shown must be solid red or black above the flanks, excluding birth marks.
16. Following the selection of the Grand and Reserve Grand Female and the Cow/Calf Champion and Reserve Champion there will be the selection of Supreme Female to be chosen from the Grand Champion Female and the Champion Cow/Calf. Supreme Female will not receive additional MOE points.

#### **PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS**

To receive MOE points, all cattle must have the following performance data submitted and on file at the North American Limousin Foundation: a) birth weight (bulls and heifers); b) weaning weight (bulls and heifers); c) Yearling weight (bulls and heifers); d) Scrotal at 1 year of age (bulls); e) Pregnancy test (any female 600 days old at seasons end); f) Breeding Soundness Exam and Semen Test (all bulls over 400 days old).

NOTE: All performance data must be submitted by December 1, 2015. Failure to have documentation on file at NALF by this date will result in disqualification from the MOE program and no points will be awarded. It is the responsibility of the breeder/owner/exhibitor to submit this information; NALF will not send any communication to breeder/owner/exhibitor requesting this information.

#### **CREDIBILITY REQUIREMENT**

In order to maintain a high degree of integrity and credibility in all Limousin shows, all owners and exhibitors will be expected to adhere to all North American Limousin Foundation rules and regulations regarding exhibition of Limousin cattle. In addition, adhering to any other rules or regulations deemed suitable by particular show, fair or exhibition.

1. American Royal entry forms properly filled out and accompanied by appropriate fees must be postmarked, or submitted online (online entries will only be available until September 16), on or before September 20, 2016.
2. All animals exhibited must be recorded in the name of the exhibitor by September 10, 2016. A copy of the registration paper or an affidavit of registration must accompany each animal to the show. It is not necessary to mail registration certificates with entries. This will be a four-division show: 1.) Purebred/Percentage Bulls, 2.) Fullblood Bulls, 3.) Purebred/Percentage Females and 4.) Fullblood Females. Group classes may contain both Fullblood and Purebred/Percentage animals.
3. All breeding animals exhibited in an ALR sponsored show must be recognized with the ALR and contain a minimum of fifty percent (50%) or greater Lowline.
4. Proof of satisfactory semen evaluation for bulls born prior to May 1, 2015 must be submitted at time of check-in.
5. Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of show entry deadline. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual classes.
6. All cattle must be properly tattooed, including herd prefix and will be inspected at the show. Tattoo must be legible and must match registration papers.
7. All cattle must meet the health requirements set out by the show management. Any deviation will be just cause for immediate disqualification from the show.
8. All bulls born before January 1, 2016 must show with a nose lead. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show officials.
9. **Any female with a calf at side, regardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class.** All females born before August 31, 2014 must be shown with calf at side. All females born September 1, 2014 through April 30, 2015 must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of safe in calf will apply to: 1.) a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian or 2.) females shown with calf at side.
10. All females shown in Cow-Calf class with a calf over 150 days of age must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian.

11. Cow-Calf classes – **Any female with a calf at side, regardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class.** Calf must be cow's natural calf. Cows that are exhibited with calves at the side must be lactating. Calves must not exceed 270 days of age on day of judging and must be nursing. Calf entries in the Cow-Calf class may be shown individually providing individual entry has been made. Cows may be evaluated and screened out of the show on the basis of udder quality. The determination of the show committee will be final.
12. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation, or not abiding by the show rules, will be disqualified and denied the privilege of showing.

### **PREMIUMS**

Premiums will be paid through 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each class. First place in each individual class will receive fifty dollars (\$50) and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded to 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place on a graduated basis after the show has been completed. Entries found to be misrepresented, or persons not abiding by the show rules may be disqualified from showing.
2. All animals must be registered in the AMAA or CMAA and the original certificate presented at check-in.
3. Tattoos will be checked, must be legible, and correspond exactly with the registration certificate. Other than a brucellosis calf hood tattoo, there shall be no permanent identification marks other than those noted on the certificate of registry.
4. The attempted surgical or non-surgical alteration or conformation of an animal is prohibited, except for dehorning. Cattle are to be shown in their natural conformation.
5. The use of false tailheads or adding hair or other material to any part of the animal's body is prohibited.
6. The dyeing or artificial changing of the existing color pattern and color will be prohibited.
7. All animals over 7 months of age must be dehorned.
8. Any and all cattle shall be made available to have blood drawn for parentage verification, detection of foreign substances or the presence of altering. If recorded parent is excluded as a result of blood typing, the owner may at his expense, request the AMAA to determine the actual parent. Failure to determine parentage will result in disqualification of that animal from the AMAA Herdbook.
9. Bulls 10 months of age and older must be shown with a bull lead in place.
10. Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection.
11. Bulls exhibited at 14 months of age or older must have had a positive semen test and a certificate to that effect must be available for inspection.
12. Exhibitors shall wear show harnesses to exhibit entry numbers and performance data cards for all AMAA sponsored shows.
13. No artificial filling allowed.

14. Protests must be submitted in writing at least 24 hours prior to the beginning of judging or at the conclusion of judging. Written protests are accompanied by \$150 refundable fee and three (3) signatures of current AMAA members. Judging procedures will not be interrupted for protest investigation and, depending on the basis of the protest a decision may be withheld until a complete investigation is made. All protests must also adhere to the American Royal protest rules found under Rules & Regulations in the American Royal premium book information.

American Royal entry forms properly filled out and accompanied by appropriate fees must be postmarked, or submitted online (online entries will only be available until September 16), by September 20, 2016.

### **RULES**

1. All bulls and females are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the Board of Directors of the Missouri Simmental Association and Progress Through Performance (PTP) rules of the American Simmental Association. Under the rules set forth by the PTP guidelines, the Missouri Simmental Association reserves the right to collect DNA from any or all animals for which entry applications are received. Verification of parentage will be done through the American Simmental Association and all discrepancies will be handled by them.
2. All animals must be registered with the American Simmental Association. **Original registration papers must accompany all animals at the time of check-in.**
3. EPD's, scrotal measurement, and other data determined by show officials may be collected at check-in. EPD's and data collected will be printed for each animal in the show program and provided to the judge to use in conjunction with visual appraisal.
4. All bulls 15 months of age and older (born before August 1, 2015) must have a semen test/breeding soundness exam and show to be a satisfactory breeder. All bulls 12 months of age or older must be shown with a nose lead or ring. All females 18 months of age or older (born before May 1, 2015) must be certified pregnant by a licensed, non-owner veterinarian or have certification that she has been used in embryo transfer. Documentation on the above must be provided before an animal is eligible to show.
5. All animals shall be subject to a medical examination by a competent veterinarian in order to determine age and the decision of the examining veterinarian is final with respect thereto.
6. Any animal upon check-in which does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks or hot-branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on its registration certificate is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals cannot be re-tattooed and re-checked at the show.

7. No forced stomach filling by pump or any other means will be allowed. Animals, owners/exhibitors and fitters may be disqualified for such action.

## GROUP CLASSES

Percentage animals may be used in group classes but may not make up the total of any one group. Purebred and Percentage animals' placings in individual classes will be used to determine the Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder. No premiums will be paid in group classes.

74. **Produce of Dam** – Two animals, either sex, from same dam. Must have shown in individual classes to be eligible. May be owned by more than one exhibitor.
75. **Get-of-Sire** – Three animals, any age, both sexes represented, sired by one bull. May be owned by more than one exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in individual classes.
76. **Breeder's Group** – Five head, both sexes represented, previously shown in individual classes. This group must be bred and owned by the exhibitor or the immediate family. Registration papers must show breeder or immediate family as current owner.
77. **Premier Exhibitor** – Based on points accumulated in individual classes. Animals must be owned by exhibitor or immediate family member. Awarded with the following point system: 1<sup>st</sup> place = 5 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 4 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 3 points, 4<sup>th</sup> place = 2 points, 5<sup>th</sup> place = 1 point. No points will be given for champions or group placings. – Banner, Simmental Plaque
78. **Premier Breeder** - Based on points accumulated in individual classes on animals bred, but not necessarily owned or exhibited by one individual, immediate family member or firm. Same point system as that used for Premier Exhibitor. – Banner, Simmental Plaque
