



American Royal Virtual Field Trip Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Is the American Royal Field Trip on a specific day (or days) as it has been in the past?

A. No. The American Royal Virtual Field Trip will take place throughout the academic year with new content releasing the first Friday of each month, following the launch on September 11.

Q. What are the topics for each month?

A. The fall semester will include: September - Dairy, October - Harvest on the Farm, November - UMB Grocery Market Challenge and December – Veterinary Science

Q. How can I access the content?

A. Visit our Field Trip learning site at https://americanroyaleducation.thinkific.com/enroll/860548?price_id=920014 to create an account and enroll in the program.

Q. What do I do once I have created an account?

A. You will receive a confirmation email once you have created an account and been enrolled in the Field Trip program. You will then have access to the Field Trip content, starting with the preview chapter.

Once you have created an account, you can Sign In to your site:

- Check your Thinkific welcome email and go to your Site URL. If you are not sure what that is, see Creating an Account.
- Click Sign In at the top right hand side of your site.
- Enter your email address and password.
- Click Sign In.

- Click My Dashboard at the top of the page to navigate to your enrolled programs.
- Select Field Trip to begin learning!

Q. How much does it cost?

A. Through the generosity of our sponsors, the American Royal Field Trip program is free of charge.

Q. Does the monthly content ever expire?

A. No. Once one month of course content has been presented, it will continue to live on the site through the academic year. Teachers and parents can access past tours and activities even after new content is released.

Q. What grade levels should participate in the American Royal Field Trip?

A. The content is created for a third grade audience, however, the tours and activities are appropriate for second through fourth grade. If you are looking for lesson enhancements for additional online learning opportunities, this is a great option for teachers and students.
