TEAM INFORMATION:

Backyard BBQ Teams may only compete if they meet the requirements defined by KCBS – See supporting documents posted to our website. All Teams/any teams may compete in the Steak Contest

RULES AND GUIDELINES:

- Contestants are <u>NOT</u> allowed to sell food, drinks, or other items from their team space without the prior approval of the American Royal
- Team space will be assigned based on the order that teams register and is at the American Royal and the BBQ committee's discretion. Teams are <u>NOT</u> allowed to host bands, DJ's, artists or entertainers at or inside of their team space
- Water is available in limited locations. Please bring containers and/or carts to transport water to your area.
- Vehicles One vehicle is allowed within each team space if a team chooses to do so or may park in general parking for no charge. Vehicles parked inside of team spaces are not allowed to move during public hours. A "vehicle" can be either an RV or personal vehicle, but not both
- Contestants shall supply all their own cooking devices, utensils, preparation tables, fire extinguishers, etc.
- Electric will be available at 12:00 PM on Friday, March 22 for those who purchased drops. Electrical does not come with your space! They CANNOT be combined to make a 220V circuit. Please note that <u>up to 150</u> <u>ft. of power cord may be necessary for your connection.</u> Cannot be purchased on-site.
- All team must be loaded out and their space cleaned by 6:00 PM Saturday March 25. Teams are responsible for disposing of all waste their team creates in the appropriate containers (ie. trash, ash, gray water, etc.)
- Animal Policy No small animals are allowed, except service animals
- Safety No skateboarding, bicycle riding, roller blading, golf carts, or scooter riding on premises is allowed
- Weapon policy No weapons are allowed on property, including weapons carried by individuals with valid conceal and carry permits
